Specialized Victim Assistance Program offers support and information to women, children and men who have been victimized as a result of:

- Sexual assault
- Violence in an intimate relationship
- Child sexual abuse (recent or in the past)
- Elder abuse
- Criminal Harassment (stalking)

**Victims of these crimes often have special needs when dealing with the justice system.**
